



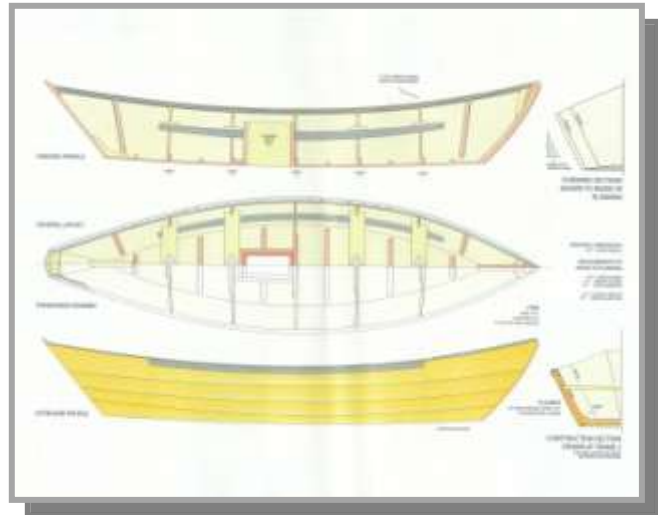
2010 Building Workshop

Build a Dory Workshop – October 4th – 8th

Come join us for a week of work and learning as we build a Dory from start to finish, and display it at its new 'home' – the Wooden Boat Museum of Newfoundland & Labrador.

The Dorya 15 ft Grandy Dory, will be constructed using the lines taken from the #2 Dory of the ill fated Norma & Gladys, which is on display at the Museum, donated by John Quinton of Portugal Cove in October 2009.

Work alongside master boat builder Jerome Canning - learn the history of the Dory – and its importance in the history of our province. You will leave the week –long workshop with a sense of pride knowing you have had a hand in this vessels construction – and helped the WBMNL carry out its mission ...to safeguard the legacy of our provinces wooden boat building traditions!



Workshop will take place at the Museum building in Winterton from Monday October 4th to Friday October 8th. Registration fee, including 5 day building workshop, lunch & snacks is \$400/ person. A package including all above as well as 4 nights' accommodations/meals at the George House B&B or Inn By the Bay is also available – single occupancy = \$925.00 - \$970.00 or double occupancy = \$1100.00 – \$1145.00
